1

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Albacore, A-Class catamaran, Flying Scot, Chesapeake 20, and Laser (full and radial rigs will be race together unless fleet size permits) classes.
- 2.2 Any sailor who is has recently shown symptoms, is awaiting results, or actively shows symptoms of Covid-19 is not permitted to compete.

3 ENTRY

Registration <u>must</u> be completed on the regatta's webpage (link below). The club will not provide access to a computer, tablet, or smart phone, so it is highly recommended to complete the registration and payment before coming to the event.

- 9.1 For each class, prizes will be given to the first-place finisher in classes with three or fewer entries, the first two finishers in classes with six or fewer entries, and the first three finishers in classes with seven or more entries.
- 9.2 The Dave Irey Memorial perpetual trophy will be awarded to first place finisher in the class with the largest number of registered competitors.

10 COURSES

10.1 Courses will be set around racing marks as declared in the Sailing Instructions and Appendix B.

11.1 For the Catamaran classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.
