2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 All boats must be helmed by a full or associate member of the United States Albacore Association or any other national Albacore Association.

NUMBER AND SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1 Several races may be sailed on any day at the discretion of the race committee (no upper limit). The warning signal for the first race of each day scheduled as indicated below.

7.1 WRSC has two crane launches (lifting harness not provided) and beach launch available by dolly.

8 MEASUREMENT

- All boats must be accompanied by a valid measurement certificate with buoyancy endorsement. All boats must comply with the rules and regulations for this event.
- 8.2 No provision will be made for issuing new measurement certificates or endorsements at the regatta.
- 8.3 All measurement must be completed in advance of the event.

9 SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- 9.1 Each boat must carry safety equipment according to US Coast Guard Regulations or CE Certification.(1 PFD per person, sound signal, paddle, bailer).
- 9.2 In addition, each boat must carry on board during the regatta a line, suitable for towing, at least 1/4" and 30 feet in length.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at the check-in/late registration table and may be posted online by September 20, 2019 at the US Albacore Association website and regatta website. SIs will govern in case of any inconsistency with this NOR.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 The low point system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply. Completion of at least one race shall constitute a series
- 11.2 One race will be dropped if 6 or more races are sailed.

12 CREW CHANGES

12.1 Crew changes during the event may not be made unless permission is granted by the organzing committee in advance.

 Roger Thomas Senior Trophy Top boat with combined crew age > 110 years *
 Bill Shore Trophy Top woman helm *
 Lockley-Newport Trophy Top helm 22 years or under as of last day of racing *
 Endurance Award Lowest placing boat that finishes every race in the President's Fleet
- *Winners of top awards in President's Fleet may not be eligible.
